DECLARATION OF LESLIE MANOOKIAN

- I, Leslie Manookian, declare as follows:
- I am over the age of 18 and the executive director of Health Freedom Defense Fund ("HFDF"), a plaintiff in this lawsuit. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and could testify competently to them if called to do so. I am submitting this declaration in support of our motion for a preliminary injunction to prevent the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services from denying Bingbing Yu's intended application for lawful permanent residence due to her inability to provide proof of vaccination against COVID-19, as well as our request that the Court extend that injunction nationwide to protect people who are similarly situated to Ms. Yu and her family.
- HFDH is a not-for-profit public benefit Wyoming corporation with its 2. headquarters in Ketchum, Idaho. HFDF is a member-supported organization that seeks to advocate for and educate the public on the topics of medical choice, bodily autonomy, and self-determination, and that opposes laws and regulations that force individuals to submit to the administration of medical products, procedures, and devices against their will. HFDF's supporters include people across the United States who are directly affected by the subject actions of Defendants. They could have joined this suit but have chosen to rely on HFDF to represent their interests in this case. The interests at stake in this case fall within HFDF's mission. Neither the claims asserted by HFDF, nor the relief requested by it, require the individual participation of its supporters.
- 3. HFDF has been especially active since the COVID-19 pandemic started. That includes advocating for, and supporting, people who declined to take the COVID-19 shot.
- During the fall of 2021, the federal government added COVID-19 to the 4. list of "vaccine-preventable diseases" that people seeking green cards must show

proof of vaccination against. as of October 1, 2021. HFDF has been advocating against that action since then, as there was ample evidence even back in 2021 that the COVID-19 shot did not prevent people from being infected with the virus that causes COVID-19.

- 5. That evidence has grown since then. In fact, the evidence is now overwhelming.
- Despite this fact, the CDC has not withdrawn its recommendation of COVID-19 as being a "vaccine-preventable disease" that can be required for immigration purposes. And the USCIS continues to deny relief to people who have not taken the COVID-19 shots, including Ms. Yu.
- But she is not the only one. HFDF has been contacted by dozens of 7. people who were denied green cards purely because they could not show proof of vaccination against COVID-19. I believe there are hundreds, if not thousands, more. People are still being denied green cards today for that reason, and that reason alone. Families are being separated, too. I know of at least one family who was planning to move to the United States this month or next, but the father must stay in New Zealand because he has not taken the COVID-19 shot, and he is being barred from entry by the government's policy. And I am informed and believe that this policy will continue this year if a court does not stop it.
